Dear Mr. Speaker and Madame President,

On behalf of the more than 3,000 proud union members the MSCA represents, thank you for the enactment of H.3854 in the face of the Supreme Court's ruling in the *Janus* case. The bill undoes some of the most detrimental aspects of the Court's ruling.

I respectfully request that both chambers reject the governor's recommended amendments and re-enact H.3854 as originally sent to the governor.

While citing privacy rights of public employees the governor fails to acknowledge that the bill better protects personal contact information of public employees than under existing law as the bill clarifies public record exemptions.

Ensuring that bargaining unit representatives have access to accurate employee contact information simply reinforces what is already in many existing collective bargaining agreements, and allows for better representation of unit members.

The fact that the bill was pass by overwhelmingly bi-partisan votes in each chamber reflects the carefully considered nature of this legislation.

Thank you for your continued support of public sector unions across the Commonwealth.
