MOTION

MOVED: To adopt the resolution below

Whereas Florida Senate Bill 256, passed by the Florida House last week, will take away the voice of hundreds of thousands of Florida workers.

Whereas SB 256 is designed to take away the long-standing ability of union members to choose to have dues deducted from their paychecks and requires that a 60-percent majority of eligible employees pay dues in order for a union to exist.

Whereas SB 256 also requires that local unions submit audited financial statements that will cost locals \$12,000 to \$15,000 every year to produce, which is two or three times the annual revenue of some small unions.

Therefore be it Resolved,

1. That the MSCA condemns Florida Senate Bill 256
2. That MSCA's NEA delegates stand in solidarity with the Florida Education Association at the July 2023 NEA Annual Meeting in Orlando, Florida.
